A) NYCC Urban Grass Cutting: Noted correspondence received regarding revised survey by NYCC of urban grass cutting and whether the parish council wished to take this on. Previously paid to cut 6 times 2060 sq m, now reducing to 5 times of 911 sq m. Under delegated powers and in conjunction with Chairman Cllr TJ, Clerk had confirmed with NYCC that would continue with urban grass cutting. Maps of area identified were reviewed B) Review of Grass Cutting & Strimming Arrangements in Aislaby: Current grass cutting arrangements, and those required by NYCC were compared. Noted that all areas were covered apart from the seat area near the war memorial. Cllr TJ to speak with Cllr RD about this area and whether to pass to current contractor to undertake – to be discussed further at next meeting
