 - a) Northern Powergrid Wayleave Request -To consider and decide whether to grant the request for a Wayleave over Garth 14 for the proposed electricity supply to cabins at Aislaby Moor for the sum of £1.15 per annum relating to 36m of underground cable: It was noted that the person requiring the electricity supply had contacted a Cllr to advise that they had signed a contract and paid for the cabling not to go across the Garth. Following discussion it was RESOLVED not to give permission for the cabling to cross the Garth and not to sign the Wayleave agreement, and to advise that the parish council was aware of the alternative route agreement.
