### **PARISHIONER MATTERS** 4

The following issues were raised:

- Parking on main road out of hand especially near toilets, church and entrance to Lodge Farm. Felt that parking outside the church against highway code and made it VJP difficult to negotiate when having a trailer. Concerned about parking on both sides of the road. Request to look at yellow lines in the village and close to the monument. To put on future agenda of parish council to discuss
- Parking in the bus stop was raised. However, response advised that a lavby and not a dedicated bus stop
- Affordable Housing within the village was raised. In response, advised that project **VJP** by Broadacres has been pulled due to government financial constraints – there had been consultations within the village by Broadacres at the time of the project. SBC currently in liaison with NYMNPA regarding alternatives and parish council waiting for response
- Excess gravel on roads that have potential to fill grates if heavy rainfall. Clerk to report to NYCC under delegated powers
- Concern about people parking in Aislaby and catching the bus to Teesside response that no further action can be taken on the matter
